Meet Mahoy Soy, a 14-year-old girl living in Cambodia. Each and every day she helps support her family by laboring in the rice fields on her parent's farm, while also taking care of her two younger siblings.



After United World Schools opened a facility in Mahoy's village, she – **along with the thousands of other young people UWS is currently working with** – now have access to a basic education. This is the first step towards creating a better future for Mahoy and her family, as she develops skills that will allow her to work outside of the rice fields and in the wider Cambodian society.

This February, UWS opened its 100th school across the developing countries of Cambodia, Burma and Nepal. Since then, two more schools have opened and none of this would have been made possible without the incredible support of all our generous donors. To continue our mission of improving educational opportunities for some of the world's poorest children living in remote and marginalized communities, we need **your** help.

How can you help?

- \$5 buys a child educational resources for a month
- \$10 puts a desk in a classroom in Cambodia
- \$20 provides clean drinking water for a classroom
- \$50 buys reading books for a classroom in Nepal
